
DASH BOARD: ICCM REPORTING STATUS



In the period under review completeness of reporting has increased from 85% to 98% in the annual under review on average for the five zones while timeliness has also increased from 34% to 96%. There is commitment by the district program coordinators in the districts who have followed up and work with the respective HMIS Officers. Figure 1, shows that almost all zone in the country were below 90% in completeness and later improved to above 95% through 2022 while om timeliness was below 40% and improved to equal to or greater than 95% reporting. This is evidence that data capture quality and possibly

The target is to have a completeness of above 80% as a country. Referring to figure 2 above shows districts have reported above 80%. The completeness ranges from 81% in Chikwawa to 100% in most districts. There is an improvement in Mchinji from the lowest to third position. This was so because there was strong push from the Director of Health and Social

The timeliness of reporting is ranging from 80% in Chikwawa to 100% in most districts in the country. Districts are encouraged to work hard to improve on timeliness more specific with Chikwawa which is on the dot of 80% target.

Reporting rates may have been affected in some districts (to reach 100%) because those districts opened new facilities.sites which affected the reporting performance.
