RECRUITMENT OF SURGE STAFF

The Ministry of Health has secured funds from the World Bank through the Contingent Emergency Response Component (CERC), to recruit surge staff for Cholera Case Management for a period of three (3) months. The cadres required are Medical Doctors (24); Nursing Officers (24); Registered Nurses – Diploma (30); Clinical Technicians (30); NMT (243). The recruited staff will work under the District Health Offices in Nsanje, Chikwawa, Mulanje, Blantyre, Lilongwe and Mzimba South, selected based on disease prevalence.

The surge staff will be engaged on temporary appointment to express interest for a period of three (3) months, starting from **1st April to 30th June, 2024.**

To this end, the Ministry is calling for suitably qualified **unemployed health care workers**, who are interested to be engaged on temporary appointment, to express their interest through filling the following online registration form, available on the Ministry's website, not later than **22nd March, 2024:**
